What does an assertion look like?

Rainsford was quick-witted.

"...he set a Burmese tiger trap."

Zaroff says the quote

What would the explanation look like?

Rainsford made a difficult trap with limited tools under extreme pressure.

Rainsford was quick-witted. As he attempted to evade G. Zaroff, he made a special trap..."he set a Burmese tiger trap" and Zaroff almost fell into it. This demonstrates Rainsford ability to work under extreme pressure with limited tools.

Rainsford is very knowledgeable. When he sets a trap for Zaroff in an attempt to escape being captured and killed, Zaroff is impressed. Zaroff comments that "not many people know how to make a Malay man-catcher." This demonstrates Rainsford skills since not many people would know how to build such traps.
