- Write an expository thesis
- Quote, paraphrase and summarize information
- Use MLA parenthetical citations
- Create a Works Cited page using electronic tools
- Use standard essay structure which includes an introduction, body, and closing paragraph

Tasks:

1.	Choose your landmark – make sure you have chosen a well-documented place so that
	you will easily find information
2.	Compile your research and write down your MLA information on notecards or in a
	document; make sure to include both historical information AND "haunting" information
	as you will need both
3.	Compose your expository thesis; write your introductory paragraph (turn in your thesis
	statement)
4.	Write your full paper
5.	Compose your MLA Works Cited Page; ensure that your whole document is MLA
	formatted
