Introduction

Imagine you run a newspaper called the Salinas Tribune. You have just heard about two deaths occurring at the Tyler Ranch. Since your newspaper is small, you and your staff of three must create a newspaper for the day of the deaths. Nothing this sensational has ever happened in Salinas, and you plan on selling extra copies of newspapers because of these stories. Each group member is responsible for completing at least two of the articles, which should be substantial in complexity and length. As a group, you should look over the layout at the end and proofread carefully the entire project. Good luck!

Requirements:

Articles	Details	Who is assigned to this task?
Local News article 1 (deals with events of novel)	This should demonstrate your knowledge of plot or the unfolding of an event(s). Don't forget to ask the who, what, where, and why & how!*	
Local News article 2 (deals with events of novel)	This should demonstrate your knowledge of plot or the unfolding of an event(s). Don't forget to ask the who, what, where, and why & how!*	
Editorial (deals with theme of novel)	Think of the novel's themes, then put it into an editorial-style article *	
Interview (with a character from novel)	Choose any of the characters from the novel and interview them based on one of the deaths; make sure to be true to the character being interviewed!*	
Obituary (for Curley's wife)	Keep true to the novel and characterization, but fill in information when necessary.*	
National news article (1930's)	National news event during the era	
International news article (1930's)	Global news event during the era

All articles must be your original work based on your research and readings from the book. **Write last names as your file name and place in my global inbox by 4pm on Friday December 12th!**
