Define the term, give a context definition, and explore the relevance of the term in relation to the story

Part 1: ex. Setting in *The Fly*

Setting is the time and place where the story or narration takes place. Sometimes specifics of date and location are important to the story, sometimes they are not. In *The Fly*, the setting is the office of the Boss, newly decorated and modern, and the date is after WWI. The setting here establishes that it is the opulent office of a well-to-do manager and there is a picture of his only son, now deceased; the boss sits behind the desk, and this also establishes his authority. This setting is important to the story because it draws attention to one of the central themes -how the boss hides behind his job and his comforts rather than face the reality of his only son's death.
