

## Part 1: ex. Setting in The Fly

Setting is the time and place where the story or narration takes place. Sometimes specifics of date and location are important to the story, sometimes they are not. In The Fly, the setting is the office of the Boss, newly decorated and modern, and the date is after WWI. The setting here establishes that it is the oppulent office of a well-to-do manager and there is a picture of his only son, now deceased; the boss sits behind the desk, and this also establishes his authority. This setting is important to the story because it draws attention to one of the central themes -how the boss hides behind his job and his comforts rather than face the reality of his only son's death.
